

Case based e-learning in occupational health – the International NetWoRM project

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Online case-based learning provides an opportunity to enhance traditional training in occupational health. In contrast to traditional e-learning, the case is the centre of the learning process and the user interacts with the case throughout the learning process. Since 1999, NetWoRM (Net-based Training for Work-Related Medicine; www.networm-online.eu) is an international platform for sharing such e-learning cases. This session will be a workshop with hands-on training. Participants of this workshop will have the chance to work through one or more of the over 30 available online cases of the international NetWoRM project. Each of the cases from fourteen countries is available in up to eight languages. Participants are invited to either use one of the available computers or access the cases using their own laptop. In addition, the presenters will be around to answer any questions participants might have about how they may use the cases later on in their teaching or learning. In 90 minutes you would be able to work through about 3 cases. Depending on the time you spend on each case this could be more or less. However, if you prefer to visit e.g. the next poster session, feel free to come back to us at any time. There is even no problem to drop in later, as you can start and stop with the case work at anytime.
